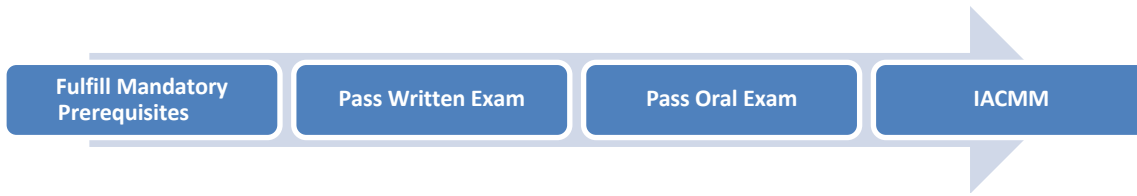


ATTAINING THE IACMM

International Academy Certification in Myopia Management Protocol and Policies



1. Skills Required to attain an FIAOMC

In depth knowledge of the following areas:

- Factors for predicting risk of increasing myopia
- Pathology associated with high myopia
- Axial length
- OrthoK
- Soft Myopia Control Lenses
- Atropine
- Binocular vision and myopia control
- Misc (Choroid, Pupil size, corneal hysteresis and MM)
- Spectacle lens options
- Combination Interventions to manage myopia
- Detailed study guide available

2. Mandatory Prerequisites

- Must have been an IAOMC member
- Must take your testing within your section unless granted an exception.
- IAOMC Bootcamp in person or online required
- Must own, use or have access to a biometer and topographer

If you meet the above mandatory prerequisites, submit your application to your section fellowship chair.

3. TESTING

A. WRITTEN EXAM *(video description of the written test will be provided)*

- Multiple choice
- Study guides provided
- Candidate must pass with minimum score of 85% in order to progress to the Oral Panel Exam
 - If score is less than 85% – test must be repeated
 - Allowed one retest at no charge
 - If candidate fails a second time, must submit a new application and pay full fee again.
- Test may be taken at section meeting or at the office of an FIAOMC
- Academic members (professors teaching myopia management, please see chair for alternate path)

B. Oral Exam

Panel will consist of 1-2 FIAOMCs

Will consist of:

- Viewing MM cases and suggesting treatment protocols
- a discussion designed to test comprehensive knowledge of applicant
- The oral exam will be delivered by zoom.

Scoring

- Passing minimum score is 85%
- Score is less than 85% --
 - Oral exam must be repeated at next testing opportunity.
 - May only retake once. If candidate fails for a second time, they must submit a new application and pay full testing fees.
